Karen's Garden

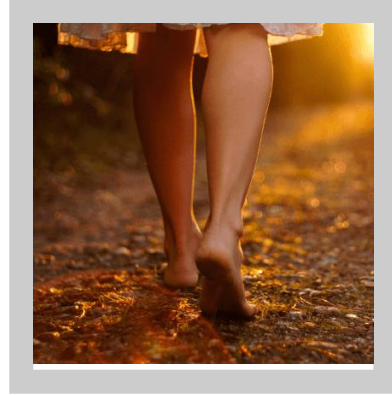
Karen is walking through her garden.

Answers and Explanations

1) B

The story says, “Karen is waking through her garden.” Choice **(B)** is correct.

2) B

The story says, “Many of the flowers are yellow and white.” Choice **(B)** is correct.

3) A

Core Standard: **Key Ideas and Details**

The story says, “Many of the flowers are yellow and white.” Since daffodils are yellow, Karen might have daffodils in her garden. Choice **(A)** is correct.

4) C

Core Standard: **Integration of Knowledge**

The story says that Karen sees flowers and bushes. The story does not say that Karen sees airplanes. Choice **(C)** is correct.
