## Answers and Explanations

1) C

Core Standard: **Key Ideas and Details**

Joe writes, "Thank you very much for the new coat." This lets us know that Joe thanks Anna for a coat. Choice **(C)** is correct.

2) B

Core Standard: **Key Ideas and Details**

Joe says, "I also like the coat because it is warm." This means **option (I)** is true.

Joe says, "I like the coat because it is soft." This means **option (II)** is true.

Joe does not say that the coat is expensive. This means **option (III)** is not true.

Choice **(B)** is correct.

3) B

Core Standard: **Key Ideas and Details**

Joe writes "I like the coat because it is green." He also writes, "I like the coat because it is warm." Joe does not say that the coat is hard. Choice **(B)** is correct.

4) B

Core Standard: **Integration of Knowledge**

Joe writes that the coat "was a great birthday present." Joe also writes, "It was very nice of you to send me the coat for my birthday." Using this information, we can understand that Anna sends Joe the coat for his birthday. Choice **(B)** is correct.
