

## **Answers and Explanations**

1) C

Core Standard: Key Ideas and Details

In paragraph 1, the passage says, "Mary and Dan sit down together in the living room." Later in this paragraph, we read: "Mary and Dan agree that a new carpet is just what the room needs." This lets us know that choice **(C)** is correct.

The passage does not provide information to support choices (A), (B), or (D). Therefore they are incorrect.

**2)** A

Core Standard: Key Ideas and Details

In paragraph 3, the passage talks about the pink and purple carpet. It says the pink and purple carpet "has dots." Choice (A) is correct.

The passage does not provide evidence to support choices (B), (C), and (D). Therefore they are incorrect.

**3)** D

Core Standard: Key Ideas and Details

After looking at the carpet with red and green stripes in paragraph 4, Mary says, "'It's just too small." This lets us know that choice **(D)** is correct.

The passage does not provide evidence to support choices (A), (B), and (C). Therefore they are incorrect.

**4)** C

Core Standard: Key Ideas and Details

After spying the carpet that is tan and plain in paragraph 5, we learn that "Happily, both Dan and Mary seem to like this one." Choice **(C)** is correct.

The passage does not provide information to support choices (A), (B), or (D). Therefore they are incorrect.



## **5)** D

Core Standard: Key Ideas and Details

In paragraph 3, we learn that Mary and Dan see a carpet with "pink and purple dots on it." This supports **option (I)**.

In paragraph 4, Mary and Dan see a carpet with "green and red stripes on it." This supports option (II).

In paragraph 5, Mary and Dan see a carpet that is "tan and plain." This supports option (III).

Therefore (D) is correct.

## **6)** A

Core Standard: Craft and Structure

In paragraph 2, we read that in the carpet store, carpets "lay on the floor and hang from the walls." They hang from racks and even dangle from the ceiling. This lets us know that there is a great number of carpets to choose from in the store. Therefore choice (A) is correct.

The passage does not provide evidence to support choices (B), (C), and (D). Therefore they are incorrect.
